


# DECIPHERING TAYLOR SWIFT


- 1. How have Taylor Swift's lyrics changed over time in terms of structure and complexity?
- 2. What are the main emotions displayed in Taylor Swift's song lyrics, and how do they vary across albums?




#### **Research Question 1:**

- Taylor Swift's lyricism is consistent throughout all her eleven albums
- Slight increase in Lexical Diversity and Rhyme Density in her later albums
- Her latest album seems to be the most complex one (while also being the saddest)










### **Research Question 2:**

- Sentiment and Emotion Analysis show that Taylor conveys a lot of different emotions in all of her albums
- In her first five albums the predominant emotion is joy, from her 6th album on, other, mostly negative, emotions are coming to the front







#### **Dataset:**

- Includes song title, lyrics and release year for each song on an actual album (in between releases are ignored)
- For a better timeline depiction, the original release year of the album is used for all Taylor's Version (TV) albums
- However for "From The Vault" tracks, the release year of the re-recording (if already out) is used
